GENERAL INFORMATION

The grapes grow on the slopes of the Hawequa Mountains. The special microclimate and the low yields result in a complex and concentrated wine.

TASTING NOTES

Crimson coloured, aromas of sweet violets, pencil shavings and dark fruit. Harmonious multi-layered vanilla, ripe cherry, oak and plum, rich and smooth on the pallet, elegant tannins, finishing with a satisfying lingering finish.

CLIMATE

The dry, warm weather resulted in healthy grapes and small berries with good intensity. The amount of grape bunches looked promising at first, but the berries were much smaller than usual, which affected the total tonnage. Greater variation between night and day temperatures during the ripening stage gave the colour and flavour formation a further boost, which are indicative of remarkable quality wines.

Napier Vineyards is located in the unique wine region of Wellington in the Western Cape of South Africa. The winery is named after Sir George Napier, who was Governor of the Cape of Good Hope from 1838 to 1843. He assisted in the abolition of slavery in the Cape Colony.

At the foot of the Hawequa Mountains, Napier Vineyards has around 25 hectares of vines planted with various grape varieties. The focus is on best quality through yield regulation and working in tune with nature.
